The much acclaimed “Musical Salute” to the Royal Air Force events moves to Loseley Park, Guildford on the 23rd June in the year of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II’s Diamond Jubilee.

The unique format of the event which features music, video, actors, narration and aircraft displays creates something far beyond the traditional summer Proms. The senses and emotions of those attending are truly stimulated. Who cannot be touched by the sound and reverberation of the Spitfire’s Merlin engine whilst we honour those that have fallen in service, all to the music of one of the world’s finest military bands.



This event utilizes the stunning still and video footage held by the RAF and the Defence Film Library which is specially edited for each piece of music. From flypasts over Buckingham Palace to Royal Reviews; from teaching members of the Royal Family to fly to their service in wars and conflicts – all “Royal” Air Force connections will be celebrated.

The spectacle in the sky of the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight, Chinook and other aircraft add a further dimension whilst a narrative helps reinforce the story. Changes in tempo and mood of the music and images engage both the emotions and senses of the audience.

Loseley Park is situated 3 miles from the center of Guildford, which has a population of 160,000. The house was built in 1562 by Sir William More and remains the home of the More-Molyneux family.

The event will be held on the front park, an area of manicured garden which slopes down from the house to the ornamental lake.

Loseley has good lines of communications with the A30, M25, M3 close by, Guildford railway station which serves central London is within 3 miles and served by local buses and taxis.
